PUBLIC NOTICE ON THE PAYMENT OF ARREARS OF SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PENSIONS


It has come to our attention that some unknown persons call and send text messages to workers and pensioners that they should contact an "unknown" person in the National Salaries, Incomes and Wages Commission who is with their files compiling and computing the arrears of their salaries, allowances and pensions as the case may be. In the process, gullible workers and pensioners are defrauded.

2. All workers and pensioners should note this fraudulent activities and disregard such telephone calls and text messages and report same to law enforcement Agencies. For the avoidance of doubt, the National Salaries, Incomes and Wages Commission does not compute arrears of salaries, allowances and pensions. The Commission conveys to

Ministry, Departments and Agencies (MDAs), approvals for implementation of revised salaries, allowances and pensions. Where payment of arrears is involved, it is the MDAs that compute it for their workers with respect to salaries and allowances, and the Pension Transitional Arrangement Directorate (PTAD) computes the arrears of pensions for pensioners where necessary.
